FIRE WORK EVENT GUIDANCE

AS OF 5/27/2020

In regards to COVID-19 concerns, it is the duty of the Ripley County Health Department to keep our community safe. Ripley County Health Officer David J. Welsh, MD, has set forth the following guidelines to ensure the safety of the community:

- Persons with symptoms of COVID-19 of any kind (cough, difficulty breathing, any fever, sore throat, loss of sense of smell or taste, muscle aches or headaches) should not open or attend the event.
- High risk individuals need to take precautions: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/need-extra-precautions/people-at-higher-risk.html>
- Proper signage must be in place in regards to social distancing.
- One family per vehicle
- No vendors prior to July 4, 2020
- After July 5, 2020 Food vendors allowed with proper precautions in place, Social distancing, proper hand wash stations. Vendor's are required to wear a face mask or shield.
- Restroom facilities must be frequently sanitized with handwash stations available
- Appropriate fire precautions must be in place in conjunction with local fire department.
